**Student Portion of the Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF) Authorized by Section 18004 (a)(1) of the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act**

1. Southeastern Baptist College (SBC), Federal School Code 015024, acknowledges that we have signed and returned the Certification and Agreement form. SBC will use no less than 50% of the funds as emergency grants to students.

2. Total amount of funds SBC has received from the Department of Education for emergency grants for students total \$36,923.

3. Total amount of CARES Act emergency grant funds distributed to date is \$36,923.00.

4. The estimated total number of students eligible for Title IV assistance and thus eligible for emergency grants for students is 32.

5. The total number of students who have received an emergency grant under the CARES Act totals 32.

6. Grants are distributed to students who were registered in the Spring 2020 semester (online-only programs excluded) and eligible for Federal Title IV financial aid at that time. The survey questions are based on the eligibility criteria handed down from the Department of Education. Those criteria include expenses related to the disruption of campus operations due to coronavirus including food, housing, course materials, technology, health care, and child care.

7. Instructions related to the emergency grants were sent to all eligible students via their SBC Populi email account.
